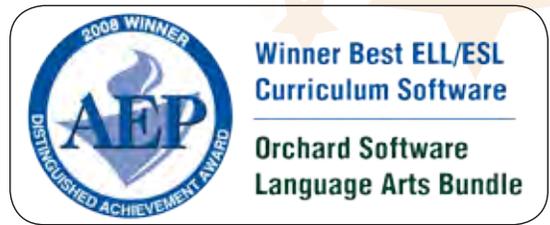

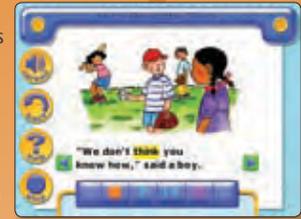
Reading and Comprehension

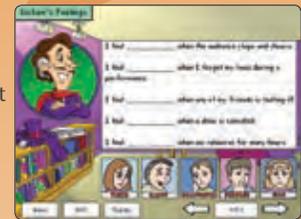
Listening

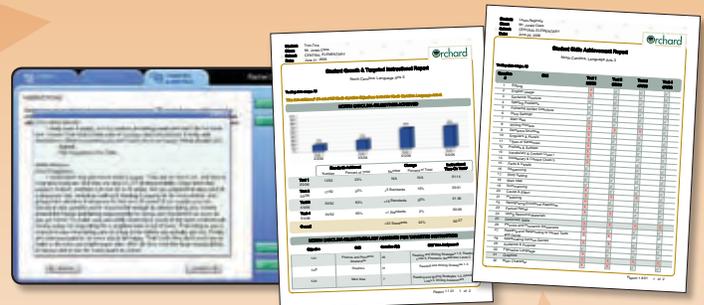
Writing
